Subject: KMCT Medical College, Kozhikode -Renewal of permission for admission of 2nd Batch of MBBS students against increased intake i.e. from 100-150 for the academic year 2017-18.

Sir,

In continuation to this Ministry's letter No.U-12012/33/2016-ME.I dated 26.09.2016 granting conditional Letter of Permission for increase of intake capacity from 100 to 150 at your College for the academic year 2016-17 and on the basis of approval communicated by Supreme Court Mandated Oversight Committee on MCI (OC) dated 18.04.2017 with reference to the recommendation of MCI dated 30.01.2017, I am directed to confirm the permission issued vide this Ministry's letter dated 26.09.2016 and remove the conditions imposed thereon. MCI is being requested to return the additional Bank Guarantee of Rs. 2 Crore submitted by the College in the Ministry as per the conditions laid down by the OC which is now possession of MCI.

2. Further, I am also directed to convey the approval of the Central Government for Renewal of Permission for admission of 2nd Batch of MBBS students against increased intake i.e. 100-150 for the academic year 2017-18 at KMCT Medical College, Kozhikode under Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.
3. The permission is valid for one year and for admitting only one batch of MBBS students against increased intake during the academic session 2017-18. The next batch of students will be admitted in the college only after permission of Central Government for renewal/recognition.
4. The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J&K, Andhra Pradesh & Telangana States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the renewal permission is granted for all India quota.
5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under IMC Act & Regulations made thereunder.
6. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of MCI and the Central/State Government.
